JOB DESCRIPTION

Provide assistance with facilitation, preparation, and engagement with children and families during Desert Botanical Garden programs. Volunteers will exhibit exceptional guest services skills, provide guests with a warm welcome and fond farewell, and other actions to help ensure that participants have a positive experience and enjoy their program.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Show proof of valid Covid vaccination, or request an exemption
- Complete a background check and fingerprinting (provided by the Garden)
- Active DBG volunteer status as outlined in the Volunteer Handbook
- Able to represent the Garden in a professional and courteous manner, exhibiting exceptional guest service skills and flexibility to work in a team environment
- Ready to play attitude:
 - Prepared to engage with children of all ages and abilities and adult caregivers
 - Optimistic, open-minded attitude
 - Ability to be flexible in a wide range of situations
- Able to repeatedly bend and stoop
- Able to lift up to 25 lbs
- Able to work outdoors and tolerate weather conditions

TRAINING/REQUIREMENTS:

- 90 minute initial training with Children & Family Education staff
- 60 minute COVID-19 Safety Training
- 90 day adjustment period
- Service contingent upon background check and fingerprint clearance

TIME COMMITMENT:

• Commit to a minimum of four (4) programs a year

- Must attend annual kick-off, or go through proper training
- Must attend Children & Family Education meetings scheduled every other month

DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITES

- Assist with program set-up and clean-up, putting up and taking down way-finding signage, and preparing materials
- Welcome and check in guests (when roster is available), record attendance
- Engage with children and caregivers
- Answer guests' questions about children and family programs and the Garden
- Perform other tasks as requested by instructing staff
- Wear Garden-branded tops, neutral tone bottoms (jeans, khakis, black pants), and close-toed shoes.
- Follow all health and safety guidelines as provided by staff.
- Notify staff when unable to come in for your shift.
- Provide "fitness for duty" release from physician to return to volunteering if absent for health/medical condition
- Notify your staff member and volunteer staff if no longer going to volunteer in this assignment.
- Record volunteer hours
